

Australia's CDR is set up to give users control over their data so that they can share their data with different providers based on consent





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

Currently banks in Australia are implementing CDR'S Open banking, other sectors will follow in a phased roll-out



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
Banks have already have a mature digital channel and are capable of handling the CDR consent requirements




Other sectors on the CDR roadmap currently lack some capabilities for securely authenticating their consumers in the digital space






Two Australian Trust Frameworks can provide other sectors on the CDR roadmap a digital identity for their consumers
