"Now the Republic of Korea should be the country that handles data best.....

It's about improving regulations so that you can use secure data while clearly following the principles of privacy. We cannot overemphasize the importance of privacy in the information age.

In any case, the government will increase the utilization of the data, while **personal information will be much more protected by enhanced safeguards.**" (excerpt from speech)

Korean New Deal Meet Korean Artificial Intelligence on November 25, 2020



"The government has prepared 'Data 3 Act' and 'Intelligence Information Service Framework Act' to establish a safe data utilization system.

We need to design the future, thinking about the importance of human-centric values as well as economic values.

We will minimize adverse effects such as technology misuse, data bias, and personal information infringement, and strengthen the social safety net so that jobs that disappear do not damage human dignity." (excerpt from speech)

- ► Strengthening "Personal Information Protection Commission" (Control Tower),
- ► Introduction of Pseudonymous personal data (activation of the data industry)
- ► Basis for professional institutions for data consolidation (for data industry)
- ► My Data Operator (new biz with permission required) in the financial sector




<u>Data Consolidation in HealthCare,</u> <u>3 institutions specified on October 29, 2020</u>








